Jane Phillips Rehab Unit is licensed by the State of Oklahoma.

Insurance

Jane Phillips Rehab Unit accepts Medicare, Medicaid, private pay, workers compensation, and many health insurance policies.

The rehabilitation staff is familiar with the requirements of most insurance plans and works to confirm benefits and coverage.

Admission Criteria

- Stroke
- Spinal cord injury
- Congenital deformity
- Amputation
- Major multiple trauma
- Fracture of femur (hip)
- Brain injury
- Neurological disorders (including, but not limited to MS, MD, polyneuropathy, and Parkinson's disease)
- Burns
- Active, polyarticular rheumatoid arthritis, psoriatic arthritis, and seronegative arthropathies
- Systemic vasculidities with joint inflammation
- Severe/advanced osteoarthritis involving two or more major weight-bearing joints (not counting joints with a prosthesis) with joint deformity, substantial loss of range of motion, and atrophy of muscles surrounding the joint
- Knee or hip joint replacement, with one or more of the following circumstances applying:
 - The patient underwent bilateral knee or bilateral hip joint replacement surgery during the acute hospital admission
 - The patient is extremely obese with a Body Mass Index of at least 50 at the time of admission to the IRF
 - The patient is age 85 or older at the time of admission to the IRF
